CITY OF DELTA

BYLAW NO. 8497

A Bylaw to amend the "Delta Fire Regulation Bylaw No. 5855, 2001"

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Delta in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as **"Delta Fire Regulation Bylaw No.** 5855, 2001 Amendment (Fire Safety Act and Permit Authority) Bylaw No. 8497, 2025".
- 2. "Delta Fire Regulation Bylaw No. 5855, 2001", as amended, is hereby further amended.
- 3. Amend SECTION 2 INTERPRETATION as follows:
 - (1) In section 2.1 remove definition numbering and re-order alphabetically.
 - (2) In section 2.1 delete the definition for "**Fire Protection Officer**" and replace with the following:

"**Fire Protection Officer**" means those personnel designated to conduct fire safety inspections and fire investigations."

(3) In section 2.1 delete the definition for "Officer" and replace with the following:

"Officer" means those members of Delta Fire & Emergency Services who are the Fire Chief, Deputy Fire Chiefs and Captains or those members who are acting in the capacity as a supervisor or designated by the Fire Chief as an officer;"

- 4. In section 2.2 delete "*Fire Services Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 144" and replace with "*Fire Safety Act*, SBC 2016 c. 19".
- 5. Delete "*Fire Services Act*" and replace with "*Fire Safety Act*" throughout the remainder of the bylaw.
- 6. In section 6 add the following:

"6.7Fire Inspectors Designation to Conduct Fire Safety
Inspections

The following persons and/or roles and such other personnel who may be designated by the Fire Chief from time to time, are designated as Fire Inspectors to conduct fire safety inspections:

- (1) Fire Chief
- (2) Deputy Fire Chief
- (3) Battalion Chief
- (4) Captains (Fire Prevention Officer)
- (5) Captains (Suppression)"
- 7. In section 6 add the following:
 - "6.8 **Fire Investigators Designated to Conduct Fire Investigations** The following persons and/or roles and such other personnel who may be designated by the Fire Chief from time to time, are designated as Fire Investigators to conduct fire investigations:
 - (1) Fire Chief
 - (2) Deputy Fire Chief
 - (3) Battalion Chief
 - (4) Captains (Fire Prevention Officer)
 - (5) Captains (Suppression)"
- 8. In section 12.3 delete "Fire Chief or an Officer designated by him or her" and replace with "Manager, Property Use and Compliance".
- 9. In section 12.3 add the following:
 - "(7) has open bylaw files associated with the applicant, the company, or the property identified in the permit application."
- 10. In section 12.4 delete "Fire Chief or an Officer designed by him" and replace with "Manager, Property Use and Compliance".
- 11. In section 12.5(2) delete "Fire Chief or an Officer designated by him" and replace with "Manager, Property Use and Compliance".
- 12. In section 12.5(3) delete "Fire Chief or an Officer designated by him" and replace with "Manager, Property Use and Compliance".
