▪ **BACKGROUND:**

At the September 15, 2025 Regular Meeting, Council unanimously endorsed the following motion:

- A. *THAT "Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 8515, 2025", be given first, second and third readings (Attachment A).*
- B. *THAT the City continue its practice of not charging for restaurant patio space on sidewalks and that an amended version of the report be brought back to Council at final adoption.*

In accordance with Council's direction at the September 15, 2025 Regular Meeting, Delta staff will continue its practice of not charging the Sidewalk Patio Permit Fees (Highway Use Fee).

A notice of intention to adopt the Bylaw was published in both the Delta Optimist and the North Delta Reporter newspapers on September 18 and 25, 2025.

▪ **CONCLUSION:**

It is recommended that Council give fourth and final reading to Delta Consolidated Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 8515, 2025 (Attachment A).
