Opposition to Unwanted and Unnecessary Pathway Project

We, the undersigned residents and property owners of 876 55a street, respectfully petition the City of Delta to reconsider and halt the proposed construction of multi-use pathway along 8A and 55A street.

Our Concerns:

1. Unnecessary and Unwanted Project

The proposed pathway is **not needed or desired** by the majority of local residents. Our neighborhood already has safe and accessible routes for walking and cycling. This new project would not improve community connectivity or quality of life.

2. Excessive and Wasteful Spending

The proposed design represents an **expensive and unjustified use of taxpayer funds**. We urge the City to explore **more cost-effective alternatives** that could achieve similar goals without imposing a financial burden on the community.

3. Negative Impact on Property Values

The construction of this pathway will **devalue nearby homes** by altering neighborhood aesthetics, loss of parking for residents in the personal driveway, increasing foot traffic, and reducing privacy for homeowners who have invested heavily in maintaining their properties.

4. Safety and Security Concerns

Increased public access so close to private homes raises serious **safety issues**, including trespassing, noise, and potential criminal activity. The design also poses risks for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers due to inadequate separation from roadways.

5. Better Alternatives Available

The City of Delta could invest in **maintaining existing pathways**, or enhancing existing park routes — all of which would be **far less costly** and more beneficial to the broader community.

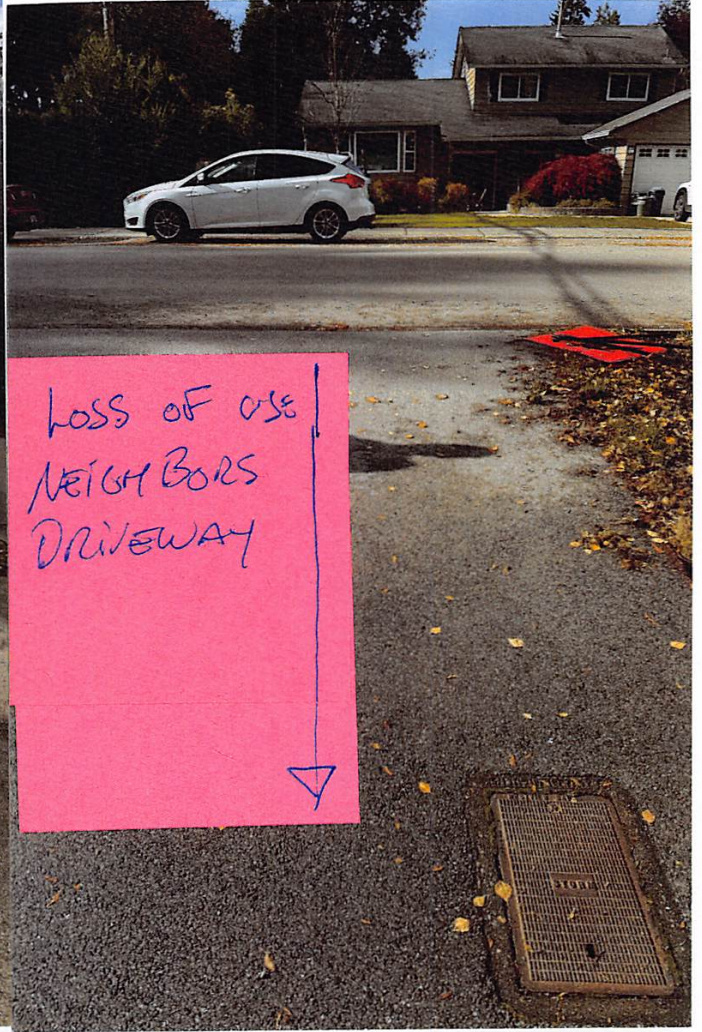






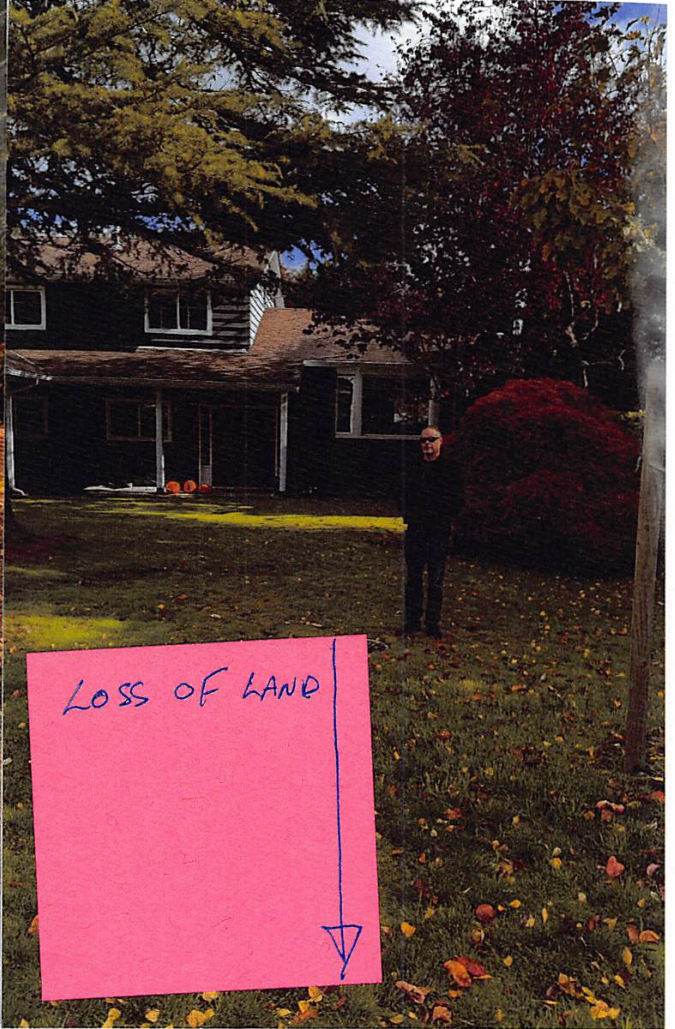
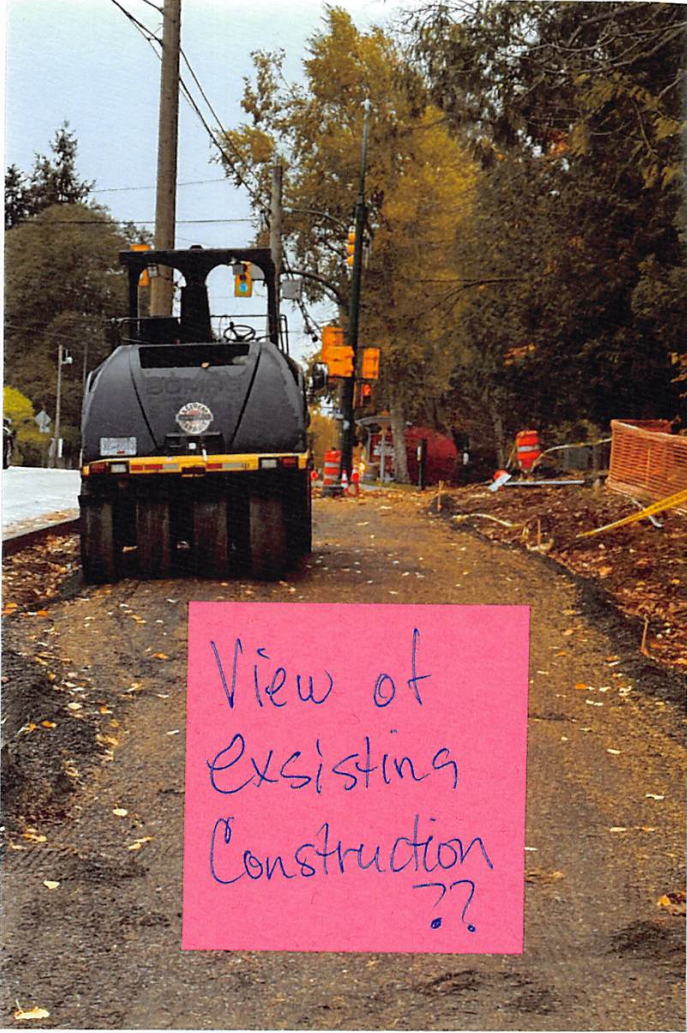


Proposed

across the street

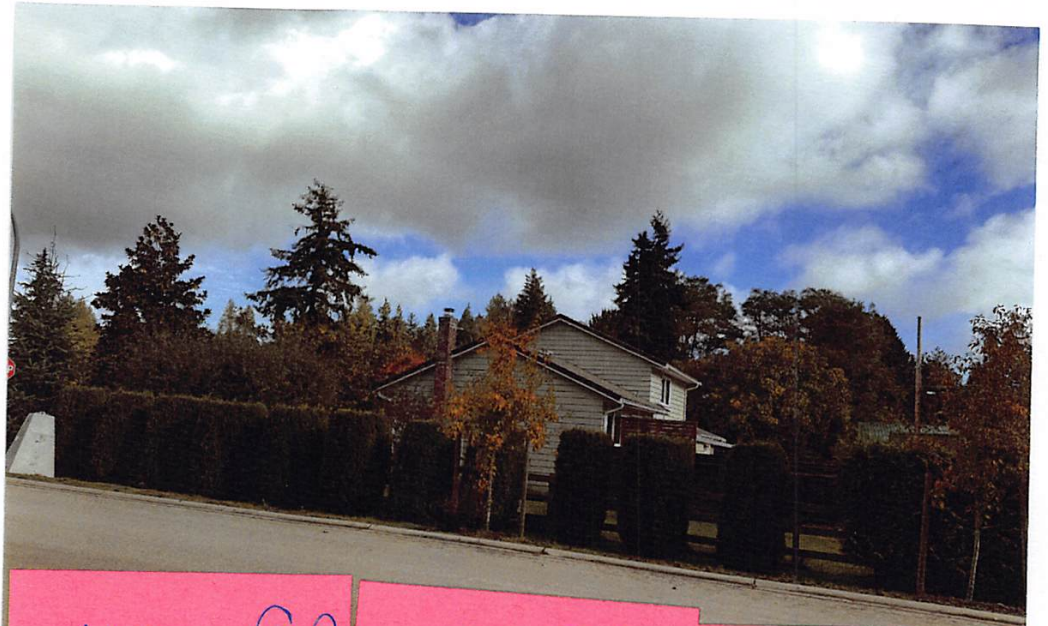
