## TRAFFIC CALMING

6. **Speeding on 110 Street at 80 Avenue**

### Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Speeding on 110 Street at 80 Avenue.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request for traffic calming measures on 110 Street at 80 Avenue. Staff advised that traffic counters were installed for one week; however, the data does not support the implementation of traffic calming measures at this time.

## NEW BUSINESS

2. **Request to Reduce Speed Limit in Imperial Village**

### Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025, regarding Request to Reduce Speed Limit in Imperial Village.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request to reduce the permitted speed limit in Imperial Village. Staff will collect data and present the findings to the Committee to determine if traffic calming measures are warranted.

Staff then advised that several requests have been received from residents to lower the speed limit on local roads to 30 km/hr, similar to the approach taken by the City of Vancouver. Staff will report back to the Committee regarding the extension of the “Slow Streets” pilot program in select areas.

**3. Traffic Signal Operation at Hunter Road and 12 Avenue**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Traffic Signal Operation at Hunter Road and 12 Avenue.

With the aid of a PowerPoint Presentation staff spoke to a request for a left-turn bay at the intersection of 12 Avenue and Hunter Road and advised that a pedestrian signal was upgraded to a full traffic signal at the intersection recently. Staff further advised that changes were made to signal timing, post implementation, and it has improved traffic operation.

**4. Speed Limit in Tsawwassen Town Centre Area**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding the Speed Limit in Tsawwassen Town Centre Area.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request to lower the permitted speed limit in the Tsawwassen Town Centre Area. Staff advised that they would collect traffic data and present the findings to committee to determine whether traffic calming measures would be beneficial in the future.

**5. Ladner Trunk Road Construction**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated October 8, 2025 regarding Ladner Trunk Road Construction.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff provided an update on the construction underway at 80 Street and Ladner Trunk Road (LTR) and advised that, as part of the on-going Parkwood construction, a contractor is re-aligning the 80 Street Highway 99 off-ramp, and a new roundabout was installed at 80 Street and LTR. Staff further advised that closures were required to facilitate construction and LTR is now open to vehicular traffic in both directions. Construction will continue in the area; however, no further full road closures are anticipated at this time.

**6. Speeding on 110 Street at 80 Avenue**

This item was discussed prior to Item 2.

7. **Traffic Calming at 120 Steet and 82 Avenue Intersection**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Traffic Calming at 120 Steet and 82 Avenue Intersection.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request for traffic calming measures at the intersection of 120 Street and 82 Avenue. It was noted that an audit of the Scott Road corridor was completed during the R6 Rapidbus project, and recommended improvements were implemented.

8. **Speeding on 92 Avenue**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Speeding on 92 Avenue.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff provided an overview of a traffic study conducted on 92 Avenue and advised that converting the existing crosswalks to raised crosswalks is recommended to address speeding concerns and improve safety.

9. **120 Street and New McLennan Road**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding 120 Street and New McLennan Road.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request for the installation of a traffic circle at 120 Street and McLennan Road. Staff advised that the location is shared jurisdiction with the City of Surrey and improvements are not warranted at this time.

10. **Increased Speeding at 12 Ave and 53A Street**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Increased Speeding at 12 Ave and 53A Street.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request for the installation of speed cameras at 12 Avenue at 53A Street and it was noted that traffic cameras are part of a Provincial program; however, staff will continue to monitor the area to determine if alternative traffic calming measures would be beneficial

**11. Increased Speeding on Shepherd Way**

Materials

- Memorandum from the General Manager, Engineering dated September 29, 2025 regarding Increased Speeding on Shepherd Way.

With the aid of a PowerPoint presentation, staff spoke to a request for traffic calming measures on Shepherd Way and advised that the request is not supported at this time. Staff will continue to monitor the area to determine if traffic calming measures would be beneficial in the future.

**12. 56 Street Construction**

Staff provided an update on the sewer main replacement project on 56 Street in Tsawwassen and spoke to the current traffic detours, resident concerns, and estimated completion date which will be in November of this year. Staff highlighted that regular updates will be provided to Council for the remainder of the project.
