Parks Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 8562, 2026

The following report has been reviewed and endorsed by the City Manager's Office.

▪ **RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT first, second and third readings be given to "Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025, Amendment Bylaw No. 8562, 2026".

▪ **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this report is to provide first, second, and third readings to Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025, Amendment Bylaw No. 8562, 2026 (Attachment A).

▪ **BACKGROUND:**

At its January 19, 2026, Regular Meeting, Council provided final reading to Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025 ("Bylaw"). Upon receiving final reading, it was noted that a portion of Section 4.11 was missing. To correct this an amendment to the Bylaw is required.

Council Policy:

Council approves all Bylaws.

▪ **DISCUSSION:**

Section 4.11 of the Bylaw requires an amendment. If approved, the current wording will be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"Within a park or municipal land, a person must not enter any fenced or enclosed area or building containing any pool, bowling green, or other recreational facility after it has been closed or locked, except for authorized Delta employees or contractors, or as expressly permitted or directed by the Administrator or a person in charge of that facility or in accordance with a municipal permit."

This update along with a few minor housekeeping updates are reflected in the attached.

Throughout the Bylaw where “City” or “Municipality” are mentioned, it has been updated to “Delta” for consistency.

Implications:

Financial Implications – There are no financial implications associated with these amendments.

▪ **CONCLUSION:**

Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025, Amendment Bylaw No. 8562, 2026, provides updates to Section 4.11, and minor housekeeping updates to additional sections within the Bylaw. These updates create consistency within the Bylaw and provide staff with the tools to enforce the Bylaw.
