

**CITY OF DELTA
BYLAW NO. 8562, 2026**

A Bylaw to amend Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the City of Delta in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

PART ONE CITATION

1.1 This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as **“Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025, Amendment Bylaw No. 8562, 2026”**.

PART TWO AMENDMENTS

“Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 8544, 2025” is hereby amended by:

2.1 in section 2.0(4), replace the word City with “Delta”

2.2 in section 2.1, remove the following brackets and words “(no numbering for Definitions)”

2.3 in section 2.1 “Body of Water”, remove the word “includes”

2.4 in section 4.11, delete all words in its entirety and replace with “Within a park or municipal land, a person must not enter any fenced or enclosed area or building containing any pool, bowling green, or other recreational facility after it has been closed or locked, except for authorized Delta employees or contractors, or as expressly permitted or directed by the Administrator or a person in charge of that facility or in accordance with a municipal permit.”

2.5 in section 5.2(4), replace the words “the municipality” with “Delta”

2.6 in section 5.4, replace the words “the municipality” and “municipality” with “Delta”

2.7 in section 6.2(1), after “Bylaw No. 8220,” add the words, “as amended,”

PART THREE SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

3.1 If any portion of this Bylaw is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the invalid portion is to be severed, and the remainder is to remain valid and enforceable.
