ADOPTION OF MINUTES

NEW BUSINESS

2. **Youth Hub**

Brad Bauman, Assistant Superintendent, spoke to the success of the City’s Youth Hub initiative, which has been operating out of the North Delta Recreation Centre, and expressed gratitude to the City for its support in providing the resource; staff are seeing firsthand the positive impacts on the youth utilizing it.

Discussion ensued regarding a subsequent meeting to further discuss the initiative, and it was noted that as per the Council report, staff would be reporting back with information on the initiative’s progress following one year of operation; City staff advised that they would connect with the Delta School Board when preparing their update.

BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES

3. **Track and Field Projects**

Doreann Mayhew, General Manager, Facilities & Major Projects, provided an update on several major capital projects underway across the City of Delta, and highlighted the following:

Seaquam Secondary School – Track and Field Replacement:

The Seaquam Secondary School track and field replacement project involves upgrades to synthetic turf, irrigation and drainage, and long jump facilities; staff anticipate completion at the end of April 2026.

North Delta Track and Field House:

The North Delta Track and Field House is substantially complete and expected to open to the public at the end of April / early May 2026.

South Delta Secondary School Infield:

The South Delta Secondary School Infield involves upgrades to drainage and irrigation for a new turf field, replacement of the existing long jump sand pit with long jump and triple jump pits, replacement of the existing goal posts with new football goals, and movable goals for soccer and rugby. Construction on the project is nearing completion.

Winskill Renewal Project:

The project's new baseball diamonds are nearing completion, and construction on the facility is anticipated to begin in summer 2026 with completion scheduled for spring 2028.

City staff will follow up with Delta School District representatives with regard to (i) tree removal for the Seaquam Secondary School track and field replacement, (ii) audio system at the North Delta Field House, and (iii) the proposed FIFA World Cup watch party schedule.

4. Harvest Drive Bus Stop Improvements

There was no update provided by the Delta School Board.

Marcy Sangret, Deputy City Manager, advised that the City's Real Estate Manager is working on the file with regard to the agreement, which is nearing completion.
